SETTING UP OF CENTRES OF CIPET

**Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:**

- (a) Whether the Government are aware that Central Institute of Plastic Engineering and Technology (CIPET) is about to set up its 12th Centre in Haldia, West Bengal;
- (b) If so, details of the Centres proposed to be set up by CIPET and the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon, Centre-wise; and
- (c) the employment potential percentage to those students passing from the institute?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE FOR CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI RAMESH BAIS)

(a) to (c) : Yes, Sir. CIPET Extension Centres at Patna (Bihar) Haldia (West Bengal) and Guwahati (Assam) at an estimated cost of Rs. 9.20 crores, Rs. 9.20 crores and Rs. 10.35 crores respectively, are being set up during the Ninth Plan period. CIPET propose to introduce long term Courses in these three Centres with a minimum strength of 150 students each. The Courses offered by CIPET are oriented towards practical work and almost all students are expected to be absorbed by the industries on successful completion of the courses.
