(a)to(c):`Health` being a State subject, it is for the State Government to provide health care facilities for such ailments.However, this Ministry has recognised 17 Regional Cancer Centres in the country.These Centres are providing tertiary level treatment and conducting research activities in the field of cancer. The list of Regional Cancer Centres is given at Annexure-I.
