- (e) by when the project is likely to be implemented?

(a)&(b): A proposal for setting up steel making facility at Salem Steel Plant (SSP) as per the report submitted by M.N. Dastur & Co. is currently under techno-economic examination.

(c)to(e): At Alloy Steel Plant, Durgapur, a new high powered 50 tonne Electric Arc Furnace (EAF) and Argon Oxygen Decarburisation (AOD) unit of 60 tonne capacity to produce 1,20,000 tonnes per year of various grades of stainless steel is being installed. The estimated cost of the project is Rs.54.16 crore with a completion schedule of June, 2006.
