Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether anti-erosion scheme to be executed with a central share of Rs. 2.30 crore on the banks of Ganga river flowing near Rajmahal has been received;
- (b) if so, whether the Union Government has issued any directions to State Government to implement the scheme within the stipulated time; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES(SHRI JAI PRAKASH NARAYAN YADAV)

(a) Yes, one Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, "Anti- erosion works on the right bank of river Ganga from Majhartola to Phelutola near Narayanpur downstream of Rajmahal in the district of Sahibganj" estimated to cost Rs.

3.07 crore was received in Ganga Flood Control Commission from Water Resources Department, Government of Jharkhand. The Central Share for this scheme is Rs. 2.30 crore.

(b) & (c) Ganga Flood Control Commission has examined the above scheme and found it to be broadly in order.
