- (b) if so, the details of the recommendations made by the Committee; and
- (c) the follow-up action taken thereon?

(a)to(c): With a view to rejuvenating Rajpath and the area around it, three groups were constituted to examine, respectively, issues relating to:-

- (i) improvement of Central Government buildings;
- (ii) improvement of infrastructure; and
- (iii) environmental upgradation of the area.

New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) has, on the basis of inputs from these groups, prepared a proposal for development of the said area. NDMC have put up the proposal on their website www.ndmc.gov.in inviting comments/suggestions of the public. Steps have also been initiated by NDMC to identify a lead consultant for the preparation of detailed plans.
