- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to set-up a National Centre to ensure Good Governance in the country;
- (b) is so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said National Centre is likely to start functioning?

(a) to (c): The Standing Committee of the Inter-State Council in its Tenth meeting held on 29th March, 2005 considered the Blue Print of Action Plan on Good Governance, including the setting up of a National Centre for Good Governance for showcasing the best practices of Good Governance and providing an opportunity to the States for adopting them. The Standing Committee endorsed the suggestion for setting up the National Centre for Good Governance. Formal decision in this respect is yet to be taken by the government. No timeframe for making the Centre functional has been fixed.
