INCIDENTS OF TREMORS

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is any loss of life or damage to property is reported due to recent tremors in Mharashtra, Goa and Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the compensation paid, if any, to the victims?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIS. REGUPATHY)

(a)to(c): No loss of life has been reported by the State Governments of Goa, Karnataka and Maharashtra due to recent tremors. However, the Government of Maharashtra has reported that the walls of 114 houses collapsed and 579 houses developed cracks in the Patan Taluka of Satara district. The State Government has provided assistance of about Rs.4.5 lakh to 325 families for house repairs, out of corpus of CRF.

No reports of damage to property have been reported by the State Governments of Goa and Karnataka, so far.
