**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government is aware that facilities/amenities for the passengers at Mathura Railway Station are inadequate;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to improve the facilities/amenities for the passengers at Mathura Railway Station;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the amount allocated for the purpose?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

- (a) to (d) Mathura junction is a `A` category station. All the minimum essential amenities as per norms are available at this station. Three works related to improvement to Passenger amenities have been taken up at Mathura viz.
- (i) Extension of electrical charging facility to Platform No 6 for starting 13 coaches train at a cost of Rs. 29.35 lakh
  - (ii) Provision of coach guidance indicator at a cost of Rs. 21.50 lakh and
  - (iii) Provision of additional landing of Foot over bridge on Platform No. 2 /3 at a cost of Rs. 10.27 lakh.
