EXPORT OF DAIRY PRODUCTS

**Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the export of casein has declined during the previous year;
- (b) if so, the foreign exchange earned through this export;
- (c) whether the export in dairy sector exceeded the target during 2004-05; and
- (d) if so, the incentives extended to such exporters?

**Answer**

(a&b) : The value of export of casein, caseinates and other casein derivatives casein glues for past few years is as under :

(c) Yes, Sir. A target of Rs.165 crores was fixed for export of dairy products during 2004-05. As against this target, the exports during 2004-05 (April-Jan.) were Rs.309.06 crores.

(d) Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) operates various schemes under which financial assistance is provided to the exporters for market development, infrastructure development, quality development, research and development and transportation. Efforts are constantly being made for opening up of new markets.
