Answer

- (a): India does not impose any trade barriers. Some countries raise issues about our domestic regulations affecting their exports to India, from time to time.
- (b) & (c): There are domestic regulations and conditions which apply on imports into India and may sometimes be deemed by exporting countries to be adversely affecting their ability to export to India.
