CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BSNL BUILDINGS IN RAJASTHAN

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the locations of new buildings of BSNL constructed in Udaipur division of Rajasthan and the dates on which these buildings were constructed;
- (b) whether the communication services have been started through these buildings after the installation of telephone exchanges and mobile phone equipments in these buildings;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which telecommunication services are likely to be started from these buildings?

- (a) Six number of new buildings of BSNL have been constructed during the last three years in Udaipur Division of Rajasthan as per details in Annexure- A.
- (b) Communication Services at Dewair and Transport Nagar, Udaipur have been started. At Wana and Gogunda mobile services have been started as per details at Annexure - A
- (c) The reasons for delay are non-availability of under- ground cable and exchange equipment components.
- (d) Likely time by which the services will be started is given at Annexure- A
