(a), (b) & (c): The Ministry of Non-Conventional Energy Sources supports research and development projects on the production and use of bio-diesel from plants, such as Pongamia, Jatropha, etc. Four Bio-fuel Pilot Demonstration Projects have been sanctioned for implementation in one village, each in the States of Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh. Besides, the Ministry of Rural Development is in the process of setting up a National Mission on Bio-diesel.
