- (a) whether the Environment Pollution Control and Preservation Authority has drawn the attention of the State Government of Delhi towards its failure to check pollution in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by Government of Delhi thereon?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA)

(a) & (b) The Environmental Pollution (Prevention & Control) Authority (EPCA) has recently reviewed the status of key environmental challenges of Delhi and have brought to the knowledge of Government of Delhi the following issues for taking necessary action.

- (i) Pollution from Thermal Power Plants;
- (ii) Hazardous waste site for Delhi; and
- (iii) Status of bio-medical waste disposal.

(c) Government of Delhi have been addressing these issues.
