BRIDGE ACROSS RIVER GHAR ON N.H. - 12

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the proposal to construct a bridge across the river Ghar on N.H.-12 in Jhalawar district, Rajasthan, has been pending with the Government;
- (b) whether the revised estimate has also been submitted by the State Government;
- (c) if so, the reasons for delay; and
- (d) the steps taken to release adequate Central assistance for the construction of the said bridge?

Answer

(a)&(b) The proposal for the Revised Estimate amounting to Rs.1200.08 lakhs for bridge on Ghar river at km. 376 of NH-12 on Jaipur-Jabalpur Road was submitted by the Government of Rajasthan in April, 2002 and after scrutiny/examination of the proposal by the Ministry, the Government of Rajasthan has modified the estimate to Rs.1291.70 lakhs and submitted the same in February, 2005.

(c)&(d) No timeframe could be fixed for sanction of the revised estimate. It is under scrutiny/examination.
