**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has a proposal for four laning of National Highways Nos. 6, 203 and 215;
- (b) if so, the details of the proposals under the consideration of the Government ; and
- (c) the fund earmarked and sanctioned for the four laning of these NHs in Orissa?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The stretches of NH 6 from Sambalpur to Orissa/Chhattisgarh border via Bargarh (length=88 km), NH 203 from Bhubneswar to Puri (length=59 km) and NH 215 from Panikoili to Roxy via Keonjhar (length=249 km) have been identified for four laning under National Highway Development Project (NHDP Phase-III). Bids have been called for the work of conducting Feasibility Study & Detailed Project Report in respect of NH-215.
