EXPRESS HIGHWAYS IN RAJASTHAN

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of construction work under progress in Rajasthan under East-West Express Highways;
- (b) the details of works like six lane roads, four lane roads, by-pass, bridges, rail over bridges and other facilities, going on under the said construction works;
- (c) the amount proposed to be spent by the government on the said roads in Rajasthan;
- (d) the item-wise details thereof; and
- (e) the time-frame of completion of said express highway in Rajasthan?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (e) The four-laning work on Chittorgarh-Udaipur section of East-West Corridor of length 106km (which is common to Golden Quadrilateral) in Rajasthan stands completed. The balance length of 526 km of the East West Corridor in Rajasthan are to be developed as 4-lane at an estimated cost of Rs.3820 crores. The proposed works include 4-laning of Highways, construction of Major Bypasses such as Chittorgarh bypass, Kota Bypass and Major Bridges such as bridge on Chambal River etc. The projects are likely to be awarded during the current financial year and the work is targeted to be completed substantially by December,2007
