VACANT POSTS OF MEDICAL CATEGORY IN ESI

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Directorate (Medical), ESI Scheme, New Delhi has given any advertisement in the leading newspaper for filling up some posts under medical categories in the month of June, 2004 and February, 2005;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any delay in the process of filling up these posts;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (e) the number of SCs/STs candidates who have been scrutinised and short listed for test and interview for each posts; and
- (f) the time by which these posts are likely to be filled up?

Answer

MINISTER OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI K. CHANDRASEKHAR RAO)

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): In June, 2004 advertisement for filling up 75 posts of nursing orderlies was published and in February, 2005 advertisement for filling up 69 posts of various para medical categories was advertised to fill up the backlog of SC/ST vacancies.

(c) & (d): A large number of applications (21808) in response to advertisement made in June, 2004 have been received and scrutiny/short-listing is under progress. Referring to the advertisement of February, 2005 there is no delay in filling up of these posts.

(e): Since the scrutiny and short-listing of applications is in process, the exact number of SC/ST candidates who fulfill the requirement of interview is yet to be determined.

(f): Corporation is active in the process of filling up of these posts and it will be done very shortly.
