**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) the number of beneficiaries being catered by a single CGHS Dispensary;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries attached to the CGHS dispensaries at Ghaziabad, Faridabad and Gurgaon;
- (c) the doctor-patient ratio at the above dispensaries; and
- (d) the proposal under consideration of the Government to meet the short fall of doctors and dispensaries in the said areas?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

(a): On an average, there are 23,591 beneficiaries attached to each of the Allopathic dispensaries under CGRS Delhi.

(b): The number of beneficiaries attached to the CGRS dispensaries at Ghaziabad, Faridabad and Gurgaon are as under:

Name of dispensary    Total number of beneficiaries

1. Ghaziabad        66,710

2. Faridabad        21,243

3. Gurgaon         34,276

(c): The doctor-patient ratio in the above CGHS dispensaries are as under:

Name of dispensary    Doctor-patient ratio

1. Ghaziabad        1:121

2. Faridabad        1:53

3. Gurgaon         1:109

(d): Posting of doctors in the above dispensaries depends on the overall availability/strength of doctors under CGHS Delhi. Further, opening of new CGHS dispensaries involves creation of new posts and is subject to availability of resources and inter-se priorities.
