ASSISTANCE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS OF HEALTH CENTRES

**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

(a) whether the Government has received any proposal from Uttar Pradesh Government regarding the financial assistance for the construction of buildings of health centres;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the time by which the action is likely to be taken in this regard?

**Answer**

(a) to (c): The proposals received from the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh in May, 2002 for funding support for establishing the facilities i.e. (a) Trauma Centre (b) Oncology Centre (c) Minimal invasive Surgery and Telemedicine (d) Centre for Maternal & Child Health (e) Centre for Organ transplantation (f) Centre for Biomedical Engineering at Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute, Lucknow were forwarded to German Embassy through the Deptt. of Economic Affairs in June, 2002 for consideration under the Indo-German Bilateral Development Cooperation Programme. The German Embassy is yet to take up the project for assistance.

However, the World Bank assisted State Health System Development Project with an estimated cost of Rs.478.07 crore is under implementation in Uttar Pradesh since 1.7.2000 which, inter-alia aims to provide quality health care services to the people in the rural areas through a viable first referral mechanism at the level of the community health centers, sub-divisional hospitals and district hospitals.
