Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has decided to set up some Recruitment Centres for various para-military forces in the country;
- (b) if so, the details and the time by which these are likely to be set up, State-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has chalked out any programme for setting up the Recruitment Camp for recruitment of the people of Uttarnchal in the near future; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SRIPRAKASH JAISWAL)

(a) to (d): Recruitment of Assistant commandants, Sub inspectors and Constables in Central Police Forces is done through Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission and the concerned forces respectively. There are no permanent Recruitment Centres for Central Police Forces. The Recruitment Camps/ Centres are fixed by the force on the basis of the response of candidates from an area and availability of infrastructure for conducting Physical Efficiency Test and medical examination etc. Annual programmes for recruitment of constables are drawn up by the respective forces.
