**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is need to convert National Highways from Jaipur to Chobhu (NH-11), Jaipur to Chaksu (NH-12) and Kishangarh to Byaver (NH-8) into four-lane as per I.R.C. standards;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to accord approval to these proposals; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a) to (c) The National Highways from Jaipur-Chomu-Reengus (National Highway No.11), Jaipur - Chaksu- Tonk (National Highway No.12) and Kishangarh-Bayawar (National Highway No.8) have been identified for four-laning on BOT (Build-Operate-Transfer) basis under the NHDP (National Highway Development Project) Phase III.
