REVIVAL OF DAIRIES BY NDDB

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Chittoor, Cuddapah and Rajamundry dairies which are deep in red are likely to be revived by National Dairy Development Board (NDDB);
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith discussion held in this regard;
- (c) by when it is likely to be revived; and
- (d) the other steps taken/being taken in regard to increase performance of these dairies?

Answer

(a) to (d): The Chittoor and Cuddapah Milk Unions are under liquidation. There are no proposals for their revival. The Godavari Milk Union (its dairy is at Rajamundry) has been identified by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as a sick union. The NDDB has submitted a proposal to the Government of Andhra Pradesh, which envisages promotion of Producer Institutions in Chittoor and Cuddapah districts to protect and further the interests of the producers. Similarly, a proposal for revitalizing dairy operations in Godavari milk shed has also been submitted to Government of Andhra Pradesh by NDDB.
