- (a) whether security at the metro Stations in New Delhi is inadequate; and
- (b) if so, the security measures taken to strengthen the security at Metro Stations in Delhi in view of the recent bomb blasts in Delhi?

Answer

(a) & (b): Delhi Police has deployed 290 personnel for the security of Delhi Metro Rail. Besides, 3 coys. of CISF has also been deployed. The steps taken by Delhi Police to strengthen security of Metro Rail include checking/frisking; use of metal detectors; use of sniffer dogs; checking of vehicles entering the parking area; deployment of staff inside the trains; educating passengers on left over articles, etc.
