**Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether a stretch of fifty five kilometres on NH-2 and NH-6 in Howrah district has no subways and underpasses on the important and busy crossings;
- (b) if so, whether any initiative has been taken by the Government to construct subways and underpasses at these crossings; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof alongwith the date by which the aforesaid construction work is likely to begin?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) On 54.4 km stretch of NH-6 in Howrah district i.e. from Dankuni to Kolaghat, one underpass at km 66.573, in front of Anand Niketan High School, Begnan, has been provided. A flyover at Km. 24.6 (Salap More) across NH-6 with a provision of facility of Staircases on both side and footpath for use by pedestrians is in advance stage of completion. On about 3 km stretch of NH-2 in Howrah district i.e. from Dankuni to Bali Bridge, six underpasses at km 666.60, km 667.910, km 668.207, km 668.336, km 668.950 and km 669.170 have been provided. At present there is no proposal to construct any other subway or underpass in these stretches.
