CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR LANE BRIDGE ON CHAMBAL RIVER

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government propose to construct a four lane bridge on the river Chambal on the National Highway No.3;
- (b) if so, whether the survey work of the said bridge has been completed; and
- (c) if so, the time by which the construction work of the above bridge is likely to be started?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) Yes, Sir. It is proposed to construct a two lane bridge on the river Chambal in km 59-60 on National Highway -3 on Agra-Gwalior section as part of North South Corridor adjacent to exiting two lane bridge to make it four lane bridge.
- (b) Survey and investigation work has been taken up.
- (c) The work of construction of above bridge is expected to be started in September 2006.
