(a),(b) and c): Indian Airlines presently does not have the resources in terms of capacity and operating crew to consider increase in the frequency of flights to and from Bangalore. Based on traffic demand, additional flights are being operated by Indian Airlines whenever necessary subject to availability of aircraft capacity and operating crew.
