- (b) the total number of extensions given to the Commission and reasons for extensions in each case;
- (c) whether the Commission visited any foreign country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and expenditure incurred on each visit?

**Answer**

- (a): The Mukherjee Commission was set up on 14th May, 1999.
- (b): Nine extensions were given to enable the Commission to complete its inquiry and submit its report.
- (c) & (d): The Commission visited U.K., Japan, Taiwan and Russian Federation and the expenditure incurred on each visit is as follows -

Japan	Rs. 4,39,635
Taiwan	Rs. 1,47,288
