CBI ENQUIRY AGAINST IPS OFFICERS

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Indian Police Service officers against whom the State Governments have requested to conduct CBI inquiry particularly Government of Uttaranchal;
- (b) the details of the officers against whom inquiry has been requested;
- (c) the case-wise details of the officers against whom order of inquiry has been given; and
- (d) the number of officers against whom inquiry has been completed and the number of those against whom inquiry is going on alongwith the details thereof?

(a) to (d): There is only one such case registered by CBI at the request of Uttaranchal Government during the last three years involving two IPS officers, Shri P.D. Raturi, IPS (UC:68) and Shri Rakesh Mittal, IPS(UC:73). CBI has completed the enquiry.
