(a) & (b) : There is institutional mechanism for periodic review of training requirement and methodologies for BSF personnel on the basis of threat perception, environmental changes, availability of new technology, performance evaluation and futuristic requirements. At the apex level, annual review is carried out during the Annual Training Conference. Changes in training policy are also carried out at different occasions depending upon the necessity and the feedback.
