India and Bangladesh share a common border of 4096.7 kms running through 5 states viz. West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram. Demarcation of the border has been completed except in the case of 6.1 kms. where it remains undemarcated. These are: Daikhata-56 (1.5 km in West Bengal), Belonia (1.6 km in Tripura) and Lathitilla-Dumabari (3 km in Assam).
