**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the unemployed youth are not getting jobs even after lapse of a period of more than 15 years of their registration in the employment exchanges;
- (b) if so, the details and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the average number of years in takes for the unemployed youth registered in employment exchanges to get employment; and
- (d) the number of employment opportunities likely to be created during 2005-2006?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI K. CHANDRASEKHAR RAO)

a to c) Employment Exchanges mainly cater to the demand of labour in the public and private organised sector. Since employment creation in the organised sector has not been significant in the last few years, time taken to get placement through employment exchanges may have comparatively increased and varies widely depending upon the occupation and skill possession of the Job-seekers. Detailed data are not maintained.

d) Government is targeting creation of around one crore employment opportunities per year during the 10th Plan period (2002-2007).
