- a) DGE&T under the Ministry of Labour & Employment provides Vocational Training under the Craftsmen Training Scheme through 5114 Industrial Training Institutes/Centers (ITI's/ITCs) including 1896 Government ITIs spread all over the country. These institutes are under the administrative control of respective State Governments. At present Central Government does not have any proposal to privatise these ITIs.
