Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has made some remark over the Bangalore express way project;
- (b) if so, whether the State Government has started the said project on Hosur Road;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether this four lane express way is expected to ease the traffic on Hosur Road;
- (e) if so, the total amount allocated for the project;
- (f) whether the State Government is also taking another five k.m. elevated express way between Yaswantpur and Peenya Industrial Estate; and
- (g) if so, the time by when the work on the project is likely to begin and the estimated cost of this project?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K. H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) to (c) : The Government has proposed to take up the work of construction of an elevated Highway between Silk Board Junction to Electronic City Junction on Bangalore-Hosur road on NH-7 in Karnataka with equal participation of Government of Karnataka, Electronic City Association and National Highways Authority of India under Build, Operate & Transfer (BOT) Scheme.
- (d) : Yes, Sir.
- (e) : The estimated cost of the work is about Rs. 450 crore.
- (f) : No, Sir.
- (g) : Does not arise.
