Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Maharashtra has submitted the Mumbai Urban Infrastructure Project (MUIP) estimated to cost around Rs.2600 crores;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the development of roads/infrastructure in Mumbai has been held up for want of approval of the said project;
- (d) if so, the steps being taken to expedite clearance of the project; and
- (e) the time by which the same is expected to be cleared?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING (SHRI M.V. RAJASEKHARAN)

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. The Government of Maharashtra has formulated the Mumbai Urban Infrastructure Project (MUIP) for upgradation of roads, construction of flyovers and traffic network in Mumbai with the estimated cost of Rs.2648 crore excluding land acquisition cost.
- (c) to (e): Such projects are eligible for funding under the recently launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), provided the State Government agrees to fulfill the Mission's reform requirements. The Government of Maharashtra has been advised accordingly
