CONSTRUCTION OF ROB NEAR FEKARY

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the proposal for construction of ROB (Rail Overbridge near Fekary at National Highway No.6 in Maharashtra is pending with the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to expedite the construction work on this project ?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

(a) to (c) : No. Sir. The construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) on National Highway (NH) No.6 near Fekary in State of Maharashtra is to be taken up on Built, Operate & Transfer (BOT) concept by State Govt. Public Works Department (PWD)/ NH Division. The General Arrangement Drawing (GAD) has been already approved by Railway in 2001. The detailed drawing and design for Railway portion of work i.e. bridge proper (bridge across the Railway tracks) shall be checked and approved by Railway for which necessary centage charges has to be deposited by State Govt. to Railways as per extant rules. The detailed drawing and design is still awaited from State Govt.
