- (b) if so, whether construction works for raising the level of platforms at these stations have been started;

- (d) if not, the time by which the works are likely to be started?

(a) to (c) There is only one station named Mandawali Chander Vihar in Delhi. The work of raising of platform at Mandawali Chander Vihar on UP line side has been started and progress so far is 50%. The work of raising down line has also been approved during 2005-06
