**Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the GAIL (India) Ltd. has chalked out any programme for supply of gas to Dhaulpur power plant;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons for delay; and
- (d) the steps being contemplated by the Government to provide gas for the said plant?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI DINSHA PATEL)

(a) to (d): ONGC has signed a Gas Sales Agreement (GSA) with Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited (RRVUNL) on 31.10.2005 for supply of 1.5 MMSCMD gas ex-Hazira for their 330 MW Combined Cycle Power Plant at Dholpur. The agreement is for a period of 12 years with review of gas quantity and price every three years with effect from 1.8.2007 or commencement of actual supply whichever is later.

GAIL and Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited (RRVUNL) have entered into a Heads of Agreement (HoA) for transmission of gas to the proposed Dholpur plant of RRVUNL.
