IRRIGATION SCHEMES OF UTTAR PRADESH

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of irrigation schemes approved for Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details of funds released by the Union and State Government separately during the last three years, scheme-wise; and
- (c) the number of schemes completed within scheduled time limit and the number of schemes which are still pending?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (PROF. SAIF-UD-DIN SOZ)

(a) 29 Major and Medium irrigation schemes of Uttar Pradesh been approved by Planning Commission from April 1990 to January, 2006.

(b) Scheme-wise details of expenditure is given at statement-I.

Central Government launched the Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (AIBP) during 1996 – 97 with a view to provide Central Loan Assistance (CLA) to Major, Medium & ERM projects of the country so as to complete them expeditiously. Eight Major/ERM schemes of Uttar Pradesh are receiving CLA under AIBP. Details of CLA released during last 3 years is given at statement-II.

(c) There are 57 Major, 40 Medium and 20 ERM projects completed upto end of IX Plan in Uttar Pradesh. 9 Major and 5 ERM schemes which have spilled over from IX Plan to X Plan are under execution in the State of Uttar Pradesh.
