Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering a proposal to construct six to eight lane 46 Km road to connect the four national highways passing through Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details of the proposals; and
- (c) the time by which the work on the project is likely to start?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN)

(a)to(c): The Public works Department (PWD) of Govt. of NCT of Delhi have informed that there is no proposal to construct a 46 Km. new road to connect the four National Highways passing through Delhi. However, Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport and Highways has informed that there is a proposal to construct a four lane Peripheral Expressway passing outside the territory of Delhi and connecting these National Highways. The total length of the Expressway is about 269 Kms. and project is to be executed on Built, Operate and Transfer (BOT) basis. The project is scheduled for commencement by July, 2006.
