- (b) If so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether no representation has been given to handloom and powerloom sector in the Committee;
- (d) If so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the details of the recommendations made by the Committee?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI E.V.K.S. ELANGO VAN)

- (a)&(b): Yes, Sir. A Committee has been constituted by the Textile Commissioner to suggest and recommend the requirements for stamping of markings on textiles. This Committee comprises representatives of manufactures, traders, importers, exporters and retailers.
- (c)&(d) : The powerloom sector is represented in the Committee by the Confederation of Indian Textile Industry (CITI).
- (e) The Committee has not made any recommendation till date.
