**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether attention of the Government has been drawn towards the news-items published in Newspapers from time to time in which it is stated that people having "fake NET certificates" are being appointed to the post of Lecturers in many Universities and colleges;
- (b) the number of such cases detected/ came to the notice of the Government; and
- (c) the action proposed to be taken by the Government to check such appointments?

**Answer**

(a) to (c): According to the information furnished by the University Grants Commission (UGC), the attention of UGC has been drawn towards news item regarding fake NET certificates.

The UGC has requested all the Universities /Education Secretaries of all the States to get the NET certificates of candidates selected for teaching posts verified by the University Grants Commission (UGC). Universities have started doing so and this is an ongoing process.
