**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Central Social Welfare Board (CSWB) has implemented Condensed Courses of Education through NGO to enable women to pass matric/secondary/middle and primary level examinations and upgradation of skills of women to meet the demands of the changing environment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of courses organized vis-à-vis the expenditure incurred thereon during each of the last three years;
- (d) the funds allocated during the current financial year for the implementation of this scheme; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken to strengthen the scheme to make it more useful?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KANTI SINGH) (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Under the scheme, education at all the three levels, i.e. Primary, Middle & Secondary is provided to girls/women above the age of 15 years who are school dropouts and who have not been able to join mainstream education system due to their adverse family circumstances or reasons beyond their control. Skill up- gradation and vocational training is also a component of the Scheme.

During the current financial year, an amount of Rs.600 lakhs have been allocated for the implementation of the scheme.

(e) To strengthen the Condensed Courses Scheme, an independent evaluation of the scheme is made from time to time and suitable modifications are made keeping in view the suggestions/recommendations received.
