- (c) whether the expenditure incurred in the said Metro Rail is more than the other countries` Metro Rail; and
- (d) if so, the total amount spent on this project so far?

**Answer**

- (a): Phase-I and Phase-II of Delhi Metro are targeted for completion by June, 2006 and June, 2010 respectively.
- (b): The expenditure incurred per kilometre of Delhi Metro is Rs.320 crore for under ground section and Rs.132 crore for elevated section.
