WIDENING OF RING ROAD AND REMOVAL OF BOTTLENECK

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has received any proposal from the Government of Delhi for widening of the ring road from Dhaula Kuan to Punjabi Bagh and to remove the bottleneck at Naraina;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the action taken by the Union Government thereon; and

(d) the time by which the said works are likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND CULTURE(SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY)

(a)&(b): The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has reported that Public Works Department (PWD) of Government of NCT of Delhi has sent a proposal to them for widening of the Ring Road from Dhaula Kuan to Punjabi Bagh with 64 mts. Right of Way in the final phase. A 6-lane flyover in continuity of Road Overbridge on Delhi-Rewari Railway Line over the existing T-Junction of Naraina Road has been proposed.

(c): The plan submitted by PWD has been approved by the DDA Technical Committee on 16.11.2005.

(d): The PWD has indicated that commencement of construction work would be dependent upon receipt of statutory clearances.
