EXPANSION MAINTENANCE OF EXISTING HIGHWAYS

Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received proposals from the various State Governments for the expansion/maintenance of existing highways during the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the action taken by the Government thereon;
- (d) whether the existing national highways matches the requisite standards;
- (e) if not, the steps proposed to modernise and bring them upto the requisite standards;
- (f) whether the Government proposes to construct bye-passes on the national highways in various States during the remaining Tenth Plan period;
- (g) if so, the details of bye-passes likely to be constructed alongwith the time fixed for the construction of such bye-passes including estimated cost, State-wise and NH-wise; and
- (h) the steps being taken to construct such bye-passes?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) Yes Sir. The State-wise details of the proposals for development and maintenance of the National Highways received during the current year from the various State Governments and sanctioned up to November 2005 are at Annexure- I. These are in addition to routine repair works carried out through out the year and emergent repair works during rainy season/whenever required.

(d) and (e) Some of the National Highways do not meet the requisite standards of the National Highways. The Government has taken up development of National Highways under different phases of National Highways Development Project (NHDP) for improvement of National Highways and other plan activities for development.

(f) Yes Sir.

(g) and (h) The details of the bypasses planned for construction during the remaining period of Tenth Plan i.e in the year 2006-07 are at Annexure-II. These are at different stages of pre construction activities like land acquisition, survey and preparation of Detailed Project Report and tendering process. It is too early to indicate the cost of each bypass and time frame for construction of these bypasses in view of the above position
