- (a) the mass vaccination programmes presently running under the National Immunization Programme; and
- (b) the funds allocated to each of the vaccination programmes?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. PANABAKA LAKSHMI)

- (a) (i) Routine Immunization is given at

BCG - Birth
DPT - 6,10,14 weeks and at 18-24 months
OPV - 6,10,14 weeks, 18-24 months and 0 dose for institutional delivery
Measles - 9-12 months
DT - 5 years
TT - 10 years and 16 years
TT - for pregnant woman two doses or one dose if previously
vaccinated within 3 years

- (ii) Mass vaccination under pulse polio programme where all children under 5 years are given one dose of OPV during each campaign.

- (b) Budget estimates for 2004-05 for

(i) Routine Immunization - Rs. 217.00 crores

(ii) Pulse Polio Programme - Rs. 1011.70 crores
