- (c) the time by which cadre review of the service is likely to be taken up and completed?

(a) to (c) Cadre review of the Central Health Services (CHS) was done partly in 2005, creating/upgrading 6 posts at Higher Administrative Grade (HAG) level and 48 posts Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) level. For giving effect to full fledged cadre review of CHS the suggestions/comments from concerned authorities have been called for.
