**Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there is any delay in the implementation of Bina River Project of Madhya Pradesh; and
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor and by when the project is likely to be implemented?

**Answer**

(a) & (b) Irrigation being a State subject the irrigation projects are planned, formulated, executed and funded by the State Governments out of their own resources and as per their priorities.

The project proposal of Bina River Project of Madhya Pradesh was received in the Central Water Commission in 1986 for techno-economic appraisal. The project proposal was examined and the State Government was requested to shift the location of the dam upstream by 1.83 kilometer as large forest land was coming under submergence and complete the investigation to submit modified Detailed Project Report

(DPR) as per the Central Water Commission guidelines. At present this project is under investigation and no construction work has been started.
