MULTI LEVEL PARKING LOTS IN NDMC

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some of the ongoing multi-level parking lots in NDMC areas is far behind the schedule and the general public are facing huge hardships;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor, case-wise;
- (c) the estimated cost of the project and the share of various agencies, project-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for the timely completion of the above projects?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIS. REGUPATHY)

(a) & (b): No, Sir. The three ongoing projects for construction of multi-level parking lots at Baba Kharak Singh Marg, Sarojini Nagar and behind Hindustan Times Building on Kasturba Gandhi Marg in New Delhi Municipal Council Area are progressing as per schedule.

(c): The estimated cost of each multi-level parking of conventional type is Rs. 25.5 crore. However, since the parking facilities are proposed to be developed on Build-Own-Transfer (BOT) basis, the land will be provided by New Delhi Municipal Council and capital investment and maintenance will be done by the developer.

(d): Sites for the parking lots have been allotted by the Land and Development Officer, feasibility study conducted, consultant appointed for development of the sites and bids for qualification have been invited and received. It is the endeavor of New Delhi Municipal Council to complete the projects by the end of 2008 as per schedule.
