**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide jungle warfare training to police force;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government provide any assistance to States for such special training; and
- (d) if so, the details alongwith the criteria fixed for such assistance to States?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SRIPRAKASH JAISWAL)

(a) & (b): The Naxal affected States have been asked to take immediate steps for imparting training to the police personnel engaged in anti-Naxalite operation in Counter Insurgency and Jungle Warfare. A sizeable section of new India Reserve Battalions sanctioned to States is also to be trained on these lines. For this purpose training facilities/expertise of Central Police Organisations are made available to the States.

(c) & (d): The expenditure incurred on training to the eligible States is covered under Security Related Expenditure (SRE) and IR Bn. Scheme of the Central Government.
